Criteria:

- Your video must address the intervention, innovation, and/or research related to an NSF-funded project associated with one of the hosting resource centers.
- The video must be under three minutes and audible.

To Enter a Video:

- 1. Complete your registration by April 1st at http://resourcecenters2015.videohall.com
- 2. Create a video that showcases your intervention, innovation, and/or research. It should address potential impact, promise, and challenges. Make it appealing to a broad audience.
- 3. Upload your video between April 27th and May 4th.
- 4. Spread the word about the interactive online event, to be held May 11th-15th.
- 5. View, comment and vote on other entries during the 5-day online event. Winning videos will be broadly recognized throughout the NSF and STEM Ed communities.
