THE 2016 BREAKTHROUGH JUNIOR CHALLENGE

Breakthrough Junior Challenge: Aims to generate excitement in the fields of math and science by having contestants between the ages of 13 to 18 demonstrate their knowledge of **Math, Life Sciences** or **Physics** in engaging and imaginative ways and help others better understand complex mathematical or scientific ideas. The Breakthrough Junior Challenge was founded by Priscilla Chan & Mark Zuckerberg and Yuri & Julia Milner.

The Challenge:

Choose a concept or theory of **Mathematics**, Life Sciences, or **Physics** that's important to understand but challenging to explain.

Create a short video (no more than 5 minutes) to teach the concept or theory in an engaging, illuminating, and imaginative way. Consider using innovative tools in your video, such as creative drawings, simulations or physical demonstrations.

Judging Criteria:

Engagement Illumination Difficulty Creativity

September 1st - Website Opens for Applications
October 10th - Registration & Submission Deadline
October 31st - November 9th -Top 30 - Popular Vote Challenge
December 4 - Winner Announced at Breakthrough Prize Award Ceremony

The Winning Prize

- \$250,000 College Scholarship
- \$50,000 Prize for Inspirational Teacher
- \$100,000 Breakthrough science lab for the winner's school
- Plus a trip for the winner and a parent or guardian to the live televised Breakthrough Prize Award Ceremony on Sunday, December 4, 2016
